

STOVES

Rocket stoves give a faster, safer, cheaper way to cook for individuals in the developing world. Our rocket stove technicians construct them free of charge for widows, the elderly and single mothers in their community in Kenya. In the five years our cooperatives have been offering this service, they have provided rocket stoves to almost every family who wants one in their village.

WATER

Sometimes, solutions may not be as far away as we think. That is the case for water in Africa, where at any given time, 40% of the wells that have been dug no longer work. By training teams of well-repair men, we help fix what's broken and in the process, connect thousands of people with a resource they need to survive.

FOOD PRODUCTION

"He provides food for those who fear him; he is ever mindful of his covenant." Ps. 111:5

In one year, we grew over 20 tons of organic produce without pesticides! In rural areas in the third world where most people still farm, our neighbors have been shocked by the amount and variety of produce grown on our model farms. Neighbors have not only inquired about our methods but regularly requested food production seminars. In East Africa, 20 farmers attended agricultural workshops. With household sizes averaging 10+, that means at least 200 individuals have benefitted from the education.

PRIMARY HEALTH CARE

Most medical professionals understand that good health begins and ends with the patient more than the doctor. We teach health seminars on nutrition, wound care, reproductive health, and what to do in case of emergency to empower families to prevent crises altogether.

MATERNAL HEALTH EDUCATION

For nearly ten years, we have been training childbirth educators and doulas to assist women and families before, during, and after giving birth. Those trained in the maternal health emphasis program have offered their services free of charge to immigrant, refugee and teen mothers in Nashville as well as young girls, mothers, and maternal health workers in the developing world. They continue to grow in capacity and professional development to be among the very best in their field.

Their input informs our service as we offer fresh produce delivery, basic home repair projects, and consistent social interaction. We prioritize widows in our proximity who do not have the support of their families (1 Timothy 5:3-16).

CARE FOR THE **PRISONER**

"Remember those who are in prison, as though you were in prison with them." Heb. 13:3

The Bible is filled with stories of people imprisoned wrongfully. The book of Hebrews calls us to remember prisoners as though we were there with them, necessitating our awareness and understanding of the hardship (Heb 13:3). The Philippines has some of the most overcrowded prisons in the world. Our team visits inmates weekly to provide meals, supplies, teaching, and most importantly, friendship. The love, care, and consistency we've shown in the women's prison over the last three years have opened doors for us in the men's prison as well!
